

PROPERTY OVERVIEW

The historic Holarud Building (former National Bank of Commerce Building) is an 8-story Beaux Arts style structure built in 1923. Original marble covers the lobby and several corridor walls. Original bank safe remains in the basement. The building is in an Opportunity Zone, and is positioned within blocks of the Performing Arts Center, the BOK Event Center, the Brady District entertainment area, and the public transportation hub. Easy highway access. Beautiful 360 degree rooftop views in the heart of downtown Tulsa.

The National Bank of Commerce Part 1 application was re-categorized from non-contributing to contributing, under National Register criterion A (Commerce) on 9/24/18 as; contributes to the significance of the Oil Capitol Historic District for rehabilitation purposes and is a certified historic structure for rehabilitation purposes (NRIS Reference # 10001013). Architecture and engineering plans are completed along with the part 2 application, but not submitted.
